Operational Research is a scientific approach to solving problems that enables leaders to make better decisions. We are offering the opportunity to undertake an Operational Research Level 7 qualification and an MSc in Business Analytics (subject to the successful completion of the end-point assessment and dissertation research project) with the University of Kent. This combines on-the-job and formal training to equip learners with the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to become an Operational Research Specialist.

Operational Research Specialists start by diagnosing and analysing a problem and end with recommendations for change and support for implementation. Typically, Operational Research Specialists will structure complex, non-routine problems and formulate specific research questions which they then evaluate and implement, interacting with a variety of customers.

Day-to-day activities for an Operational Research specialist may include using quantitative modelling and analysis to provide recommendations; developing novel approaches to tackling real-world problems; and providing impartial and evidence-based advice to customers to enable them to make informed decisions.
